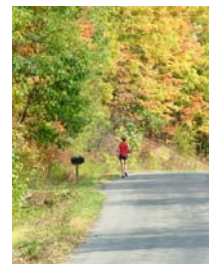


## The RIT Vision and Priorities

<b>Equity, plurality, and inclusivity</b>	Embrace an inclusive learning environment for RIT community that strives to seek a better understanding of one another
<b>Research, scholarship, and creative works</b>	Campus goal: Increase campus scholarship and research, particularly sponsored research
<b>Innovation</b>	Campus goal: Provide innovation learning opportunities for students
<b>International Education</b>	Campus mission: Provide global education experience
<b>Academic Operations</b>	Support for the academic programs; budget, space, communication, shared governance

## Charges to the Colleges

- 3<sup>rd</sup> Comprehensive Review
  - Starts AY 2011 (for those hired in 2009)
  - Develop college process for review
- External Review of Scholarship
  - Starts AY 2010
  - Minimum of 2 for comprehensive review; 4 for tenure review
  - Guidelines
- Review and/or develop college policy and procedure for promotion and tenure
  - Promotion to associate professor automatic with tenure
  - Define roles
- Define college specific criteria
- Set template for Statement of Expectations

- Part of strategic plan and gen ed outcomes
- Key pieces:
  - International Sites – Croatia, Dubai, Kosovo
  - Study abroad
  - International students
  - Multicultural awareness
  - International Co-ops
- Goal: Send 100 students to Dubai and/or Croatia
- Goal: Identify specific learning outcomes for International Ed
- Develop 1-stop nexus for IE in the new Global Village
