WHAT IS THE PRR?

- Major accreditation event
- Five years after self study
- Retrospective, current, and prospective analysis
- Prescribed format with 6 required sections
- 50 pages + appendices
- External Peer Review Process



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PEER REVIEW PROCEDURES

- No campus visit Off-Site Peer Review
- Two external peer reviewers, one financial associate reviewer
- Access to reviewers' report and financial associate's report: August 2
- RIT submits Institutional Response: September 1
- MSCHE communicates Final Accreditation Decision: November



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EXTERNAL REVIEWERS' REPORT

IS RIT IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE ACCREDITATION STANDARDS?

Reviewers required to share:

- Suggestions (collegial advice)
- Recommendations for Institutional improvement
- Requirements in order to be in compliance
- Areas of insufficient information



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POSSIBLE MSCHE ACTIONS

- Reaffirm accreditation
- Commend institution

- Postponement request Supplemental Information Report
- Other: probation, show cause, & accreditation removal



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RESULTS FROM 2010 PRR REVIEWS

- 49 institutions submitted PRRs
- 37 (76%) affirmed
- 14 (29%) commendations
- 14 (29%) progress reports
- 22 (45%) monitoring reports
- 5 (10%) Warnings; 5 (10%) Probations;
 2 (.04%) Postponements
