Student Council Minutes

May 6, 1946

The Student Council meeting was called to order at 4:20 by the vice president Bob Martán.

Mr. De Witte's suggestion is that we take it to an outside printer, probably at the same cost. Lenord Morris and Irwin Dixon will try to contact printers.

It was decided that the Student Directory will be given out to the students by the representatives tomorrow. The directories will be gotten from Bob Martin in the P & P department any time from 8:30 on. Irwin Dixon, Harriet Schrope, and Jean Krebbs are a committee to mail the directories to the A block Chemistry, Mechanical & Electrical students. The mailing deadline will be Saturday.

An election committee was set up. Don Soper will hold elections in the Photo Tec., Publishing & Printing departments, and help Bob Martin with the Mechanical, Chemical, & Electrical elections, Phyllis Kipp and Diana Lea will hold elections in the Art Department. A motion was made and accepted that the new council will meet with the old next week.

The Riding Club advisorship will be dropped until fall.

It was suggested that the House Committee should buy 4 new ping pong paddles, and also buy light shades for the ping pong room.

The cost of the Student Council Dinner was \$68.00. The dinner cost: \$54.00, Tip \$6.00, Flowers \$8.00. Student Council paid \$35.00.
