The Student Council was called to order at 4:20 by Miss Medden.

Three students are working this week, Tues., Wed., and Thurs., night. The union is open for meetings scheduled there and also the lounges will be open for students.

At the end of the meeting the Union is to be closed.

The House Committee is to be started functioning for Clark Union.
