Student Council Minutes  
February 3, 1947

The meeting was called to order at 4:15 by Bob Martin, pres.

An Athletic Committee report was given by Irwin Dixon. Wrestling is to start next week and there will be four meets. A golf instructor is willing to teach if the smoking room can be used. A motion was made and passed for use of the smoking room for golf instruction.

Phil Cole gave a report on the Food Committee. A complaint was taken to Mrs. Hoke and Dr. Ellingston and several solutions suggested. A decision was made to have a news article written on the protest for the Sprit.

The Projector Committee is starting movies at 12:25 in Eastman this Wednesday.

Council approved that the three dollar Technicolor picture fee be added to the class dues.

Mr. Collins, the golf instructor, has in the past given lessons every night for five weeks. Each student has one half hour lesson a week. The cost is \$1.75 paid by the student and \$1.25 paid by council. Hawley Lawrence and Lois Geser were appointed to take charge of getting golfing under way.

Under new business, Bob Kaplan suggested that a flying club be organized. The student interest and availability of an advisor is to be found out before anything further is decided.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:15.
