A motion was made and passed that Student Council recommend to the Policy Committee that the Institute consider sound proofing Eastman Assemble Hall.

A report on the Carnege Music Committee was sent to council by Bob Kleinschmitd suggesting that new records be purchased. A motion was made and passed to appropriate \$75.00 to the Carnege Committee for the purchase of new records and \$21.20 be charged to the budget. *in a total of \$96.20*

The ammendment for the change of the Student Association fee was submitted to council and will be voted on at the next meeting.

A letter from the Rochester Association for the U.N. was received along with information explaining the purpose and duties of a representative. Roger Buckler is going to read the information over.

The Electrical Department representatives are to elect a freshman council representative.
