

Minutes Student Council Meeting

January 5, 1948

The meeting called to order at 5:10 P. M. by President Lee Howick. Roll call was taken and the minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Pamphlets of Parliamentary Procedure were distributed to Student Council representatives.

Herschel Brown reported on the Red Cross Blood Bank Comm. and its activities.

Joe Sinicropi reported on the Athletic Committee.

President Lee Howick gave a report on the Smoking Room. Dr. Ellingson has suggested that an asphalt tile floor be installed.

John Silsby continued with his report on the Navajo Indians, and Lee discussed supporting C A R E as suggested by Rev. Cayley.

Motion made that a combined collection be taken and that the first \$125.00 be given to the Indians and the remainder to C A R E. Motion not carried. Motion was made that combined drive be made, with money collected in separate container. Motion seconded. Carried.

The coming issue of Sprit is to carry the entire story of N.S.A. President Howick suggested that the representatives get the opinions of students concerning their approval of the Constitution of the N.S.A.

In February action will be taken on the rewriting of Student Council Constitution.

Nominations were made for Vice-President of Student Council. Floyd Willard, Joan Haag and Pat Siller were nominated with Joan as the successful candidate.

Motion was made that meeting be adjourned. Seconded. Carried. Meeting was adjourned at 6:05 P. M.
