

Minutes Student Council

February 23, 1948

Meeting called to order by President Lee Howick at 5:00 P. M.

Mr. Hagberg spoke regarding suggested change of awards. He also presented the feelings of the athletic committee in the form of a letter. The letter was read to Council and is attached in original form to these minutes.

Joe Sinicropi reported that inter-mural basketball is progressing very well. He also reported that there are two goos ping-pong tables in the gym. It is not certain yet whether they may be used by the students. Paddles are all that seem to be needed.

Motion made that in the event that the ping-pong tables are available for students use money be appropriated for the purpose of purchasing paddles. Seconded. Carried.

Gambling reported by the Faculty. Requested that Council members discourage this type of activity.

Motion made that meeting be adjourned. Seconded. Carried.
