

Minutes
Student Council Meeting
March 1, 1948

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Meeting called to order at 8:00 p.m. by President Lee Howick.

Phil Cole, Chairman of the Movie Committee, made a report to the Council regarding funds used to date and difficulties of Committee due to lack of cooperation from Committee Members. It was reported that up to date only $\frac{1}{2}$ the approved budget has been used and that the attendance every Wednesday has been very good. It was further reported that he receives no cooperation from his Committee and that the work entailed is too much for any one person to do. Phil Cole stated that he has a planned schedule for the next two weeks and that if the program is to continue after that an active committee must be appointed to replace the present one. Mr. Foster, Faculty Advisor further stated that what Phil reported was correct and that some form of advertising in Spirit might bring out some active volunteers. Mr. Foster volunteered his services to conduct a class in how to operate the projector. Mr. Foster also stated that a cine-club might be started on campus to further the capabilities of students in movie projector operation. In summation it was stated that if an active committee could be formed an already successful program could be made even more successful.

A suggestion from the floor stated that every club on campus be canvassed for volunteers.

The flooring in the new smoking lounge is in the process of being laid.

Matter of Cheer Leaders awards discussed.

Motion made that a sweater be awarded at the end of the second year of cheer leading and a suitable award be made at the end of the third year. Seconded. Not Carried.

Motion made that Cheer Leaders be awarded a sweater at the end of the first year of cheer leading and a stripe be awarded for each extra year. Seconded. Carried.

Joe Sinicropi reported that Mr. Hagberg has given his permission to install the 2 available ping-pong tables in the Clark Building smoking room. Athletic Comm. will purchase 12 ping-pong paddles and a gross of balls when Mr. Hagberg's permission is approved by the School.

Awards banquet and assembly was discussed. Harriet Schwulck, Hal Burnett, Kenneth Swannie, Gordon Bull and Joe Sinicropi were delegated as a Committee to investigate the matter of presentation of awards.

Vic Damone has volunteered his time for an assembly.

Freshman Class would like to put on a minstrel show. A meeting has been called for all Freshman Representatives in room E 244 on Tuesday March 2 at 4:00 P. M.

Motion made that meeting be adjourned. Seconded. Carried.
