

Minutes Student Council

April 5, 1948

Meeting called to order by President Lee Howick at 5 P. M.

A letter from Alfred University requesting that 4 Students be sent to NSA Convention, was read to the Council. It was reported that \$40.00 would be sufficient to send 4 delegates to the Convention.

Motion made that \$40.00 be appropriated to send 4 delegates to Alfred University for NSA Convention. Seconded. Carried.

Cigarette lighters for awards have been ordered and are due to be received next week.

A contract from Bastion Bros. regarding price of award keys read to the Council. States that the price shall be \$2. 50 plus tax as the price provided 500 keys are purchased within 3 years.

Motion made that Bastion Bros. contract be accepted with the understanding that this council will pay \$500 and the next councils will also pay \$500. It is the purpose of this council to inaugurate a system of standard awards on campus. By dispersing the initial cost of the dies over a period of 3 years the price is brought within a reasonable range. Seconded. Carried.

Motion made that wording on key should read "Student Activity". Seconded. Carried.

10 week Chemical, Electrical and Mechanical blocks which are leaving school at the end of this week were instructed that elections must be held to elect representatives for Council next year.

Motion made that meeting be adjourned. Seconded. Carried.
