

# Minutes Student Council

April 19, 1948

Meeting called to order at 5:00 P. M. by President Lee Howick.

A report of the N.S.A. Regional Convention was given by Ken Swannie and John Silsby. The convention was held at the University of Buffalo. Some of the major points discussed were the Priveledge Card which is purchased by a student for \$1 and enables the holder to a 10% to 20% discount at almost all of the retail merchants. It is hoped that when this system is established throughout the country it will enable students to purchase goods in almost any city at the discount rate. It was also reported that the Region is to be broken up or divided into five districts for domestic affairs. It has been figured that a cost of 50 cents per capita for all schools would cover the N.S.A. budget.

John Silsby reported that N.S.A. has severed its connection with the I.U.S. Also mentioned was the fact that a transportation pool has been established which will equalize the costs of transportation to Conventions for all delegates regardless of where it may be.

The subject of establishing N.S.A. as a working unit on our campus was thrown open to discussion by the Council. The discussion to be continued next week. Suggestion made that a minimum number of persons handle names in next year's Student Directory. One person in each full time department and one person in each block in those departments operating on the block system.

It was reported that the lighters to be awarded are at the Engravers and are due back at the end of the month as are the sweaters and keys.

Motion made that meeting be adjourned. Seconded. Carried.
