SEPTEMBER 27, 1948

The meeting was called to order by President, Ben Short

A welcome was extended to the new freshman representatives by the president.

Mike Anderson reported on the inability to attain ushers for the student assemblies. As yet he has had no cooperation from the students.

The student questionnaires for the Student Handbook, distributed last week, have been returned.

A Social Committee for the coming year was selected. Bill Murphy is chairman and other members are Shirley Vickery, Louis Addaman, Claudia Simons and Jay Ropp.

A report on house committee activities was given by Dalinsky: A discussion on the advisability of adding a collection of semi-classical records to the Carnegie Room set was opened. Most members of council were opposed to this.

The question of the use of the ping pong tables in the Clark building was brought up. Clarence Mathews volunteered to investigate this further and report at a later meeting.

Announcement was made that Clark Union would be opened on Saturday afternoons, starting October for the convenience of the students.

Bill Murphy suggested that alternate block officers be of the corresponding block system and that the president be a full-time student, preferably with previous experience. A motion was made and seconded to that effect.

Class elections of officers will be held as follows:

- Junior Class -- October 7
- Freshman Class - October 22

A new meeting place was suggested to promote order. It was decided that room 102 in the Eastman Building would be used next week.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:05.
