The motion was made that a committee of five members be elected from council, with members divided equally among the departments to take over social functions. Not seconded. Motion lost.

~~The motion was made that this discussion be continued. Seconded. Carried~~

A committee of five members would be elected from council. This would only be a fact finding committee. Five members would not represent all departments. No power of veto. Discussion closed.

~~The motion was made that a committee be elected to take the place of class officers. Seconded. Carried.~~

~~The motion was made that a committee of eight members be elected plus the President, whose membership would exist in an advisory capacity and vote only in case of tie; representatives from each department with block alternates automatically becoming members of this committee. Seconded.~~

Not Carried. CARRIED.

The motion was made that a committee of eight members plus the President be elected; the committee will consist of a member from each department; this member shall be chosen from the six members of that department on Council, during their current block. Seconded. Carried.

The motion was made that the meeting be adjourned. Seconded. Carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:00.
