Gene Penler made a report on the dance committee. The main problem is to contact enough girls as partners. As yet, nothing definite has been decided.

Irv Dolinsky announced that Clark Union will be closed from 1:00 P.M. Wednesday, November 21, until 10:00 A.M. Monday, November 29, for Thanksgiving vacation.
