STUDENT COUNCIL MINUTES
November 29, 1948

The publication of these minutes is a new policy of Student Council, intended to enable the members of the Student Association to keep posted on the current issues being handled by their Student Council. These minutes will be published weekly, and will be available at the Clark Union desk and at other key positions throughout the school. Meeting was called to order at 5:08 P.M. by President Ben Short. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. President Short made the following announcement:

The Student Council office has been moved to a new location. Due to the lack of space it has been moved two rooms directly behind its old location. This room gives more space for meeting held in the office.

Discussion concerning the parking lot. The Red Cross is allowed space for a certain number of cars due to the fact that they contributed money for this purpose.

Discussion on the parking lot continued. The faculty has a parking lot and will not use this one. There is enough space provided to handle all the cars expected to use the parking lot.

Stickers for the parking lot will go on sale next week in Clark Union Monday and Friday noon and after school between 4:00 P.M. and 5:00 P.M.

Frank Riesenberger reported on the Red Cross. The campaign for blood is still on but interest has died down.

Due to the short week before Thanksgiving the regulations for the smoking lounge were not re-written. President Short and Irv Dolinsky will re-write them this week.

Bill Murphy asked if there were any new items which should be mentioned at the Alumni Dinner tonight.

An inquiry was made asking if anything was going to be done about the recreation room in the Clark building. As soon as the Eastman smoking lounge is completed plans for this will begin.

President Short announced that the agency for Charlie Spivak is sending a contract. The date for the dance is April 30. As yet, no definite price has been set.

Frank Risenberger suggested that a different method be used to acquire a Sprit staff. Discussion followed. Nothing definite decided.

It was suggested that it be written into the by-laws of the new student Council Constitution that Sprit, Techmilla and any student organization must have and submit a constitution to Council.

Motion was made that the meeting be adjourned. Seconded. Carried. Meeting was adjourned at 5:38 P.M.
