Student Council Minutes  
January 31, 1949

The publication of these minutes is a new policy of Student Council, intended to enable the members of the Student Association to keep posted on the current issues being handled by their Student Council. These minutes will be published weekly and will be available throughout the school at key positions such as the library, Gleason Hall and the desk at Clark Union. The meeting was called to order at 5:09 P.M. by President Ben Short. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

President Short congratulated everyone on the good work that was done to make the last student mixer a success.

President Short made the following announcements: Mr. Killip, a representative from Bastian Brothers, will be in the Council office February 9, at 4:30 P.M. and 7:00 P.M. to take orders for class rings and pins. The student directory is out and may be obtained at the desk in Clark Union, the library and Gleason Hall.

John Wait reported on the Eastman smoking lounge. The estimate for the completion of the lounge is \$1606.50. Discussion followed. It was suggested that the estimate be approved by Council and also by the Alumni Association. The motion was made that the estimate for the Eastman smoking lounge be approved by Council with the stipulation that the Alumni Association approve it. Seconded. Vote taken. Carried.

Eugene Penler reported on the Alumni Association meeting last week. The Alumni Association can be counted on at any time to help Council with whatever projects they may undertake. Mr. Penler reported to the Alumni Association on the last Student Mixer which they sponsored.

President Short read the regulations for the smoking lounge. Corrections were asked for. These rules will be enforced by the janitors and members of Council. A motion was made that the rules for the Eastman smoking lounge be accepted as they stand. Seconded. Vote taken. Carried. A discussion followed concerning the lounge. It was decided that permission for the use of the lounge will be obtained from Student Council. A definite set of rules concerning decorations in the lounge will be made up.

The dance April 30th. will be a closed affair. R.I.T. students, Staff and Alumni.

Frank Rosenberg has submitted a set of proposals concerning the election of the editor of Sprit and the staff. The present editor and student manager of Sprit will meet with the president concerning this.

President Short again asked for a representative for the Red Cross.

A date is to be set for the Student Council banquet sometime before May 15. Vice-president Eugene Penler has charge of this.

Miss Medden announced that the Residence Hall girls have a 2:30 A.M. permission for the dance April 30th.

A motion was made that the meeting be adjourned. Seconded, Carried. The meeting was adjourned at 5:45 P.M.
