STUDENT COUNCIL MINUTES
December 13, 1948

The publication of these minutes is a new policy of Student Council, intended to enable the members of the Student Association to keep posted on the current issues being handled by their Student Council. These minutes will be published weekly and will be available at the Clark Union desk and other key positions throughout the school. If a broader interpretation is wanted, contact your student representative. A complete coverage of major issues will be published in Sprit.

The meeting was called to order at 5:07 P.M. by President Ben Short. The minutes of the previous meeting were read, corrected and approved.

President Short announced that the proofs of Student Directory will be out this week and the directory will be out the first of January.

Ed Pcsner reported on the parking lot. Tickets are still being sold and may be purchased any noon hour or after school between 4:00 and 5:00 P.M. in the Council office. There are still quite a few cars being parked in the lot without stickers. Bill Murphy suggested that the offender, providing he is an RIT student be brought before Council and the reason for the purchase of the sticker explained to him. If he is an outsider, then we can turn his license number over to the police and obtain his name and address and have him summoned to court on the charge of trespassing on private property.

There are several bids before the committee for snow removal. As yet none have been decided upon.

It was suggested that a number of stickers be left at the Red Cross for the benefit of those who visit the Red Cross regularly. The sticker could be placed on the car and parked in the lot and then returned to the Red Cross for future use. Signs are being made to designate the places for Red Cross cars.

Irv Dolinsky announced that Clark Union will close Friday, December 17, at 5:00 P.M. and will re-open Monday, January 3, 1949 at 10:00 A.M. Irv promised faithfully that he will see about the ping pong paddles for the Union this week.

Irv inquired about N.S.A. Nothing definite could be reported because Agatha Rudd is out on her work block.

President Short announced that the Student Council pictures will be taken Tuesday at 1:40 P.M. in the Pine Lounge at Kate Gleason for those who were not here for the last one.

Miss Medden announced that the mail boxes in Clark Union were for students' mail that is sent to their departments. Due to some working hours students do not get the chance to stop in school and pick up their mail. Mail may be picked up between 10:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M. The boxes are arranged by departments. There is a locked box for veterans checks.

Miss Medden also explained about the Rochester Hospital Service which offers hospitalization to students. Any number of students who are interested may form a group and apply for it. Discussion followed. Student opinion is wanted.

Any student who did not receive a student association card may pick one up in the Council office.

President Short extended Holiday Greetings to the student body from the Executive Committee.
