Student Council Minutes  
October 16, 1951

The meeting was called to order by President Jack Stumpf at 5:05 P.M. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. Roll call was taken.

In regard to the 1951-52 Budget, Granville Bentley reported that it may be necessary to drop all clubs from the budget and to make drastic cuts on all other groups. Pres. Stumpf announced that a poll, sponsored by Student Council, was to be conducted throughout the school in an attempt to ascertain what activities are most important to the students. Representatives were asked to distribute the forms in their departments and to return them to the Student Council office within the week.

Ben Marcus distributed forms for the blood drive to be held Nov. 5 and requested that they be turned in at Miss Behr's desk in Clark Union by Nov. 1.

Mr. Foster of the Photo Tech department spoke to Council suggesting a plan to provide publicity for all Student Council sponsored activities. Under this proposal, all activities included in the Inter-Organizational group would receive editorial and photographic coverage in the student publication. Discussion followed. Joe McKenna moved that the plan of cooperating with the photo-journalism class to provide publicity for Student Council and its functions be accepted. Seconded and carried. More information was promised for the next meeting.

It was announced that an Open House for high school students will be held at the Institute on Nov. 7, from 1:00 to 5:00 P.M. Priscilla Holt, Chemistry, Carol Newton, Foods, and Jack Siulinski, Photo Tech, volunteered to make posters from photographs publicizing student activities.

Foster Johnson was nominated for Chairman of the Publications Committee. Seconded and approved.

It was announced, in reply to a number of requests, that the 1951-52 student passes are now being printed.

Jack Siulinski moved that the meeting be adjourned. Seconded and carried. Meeting adjourned at 5:45 P.M.
