Student Council Minutes

November 8, 1951

The meeting was called to order by President Jack Stumpf at 5:10 P.M. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. Roll call was taken.

Granville Bentley announced that Norman Krug, senior, and Jim McCue, junior, had been elected as representatives to Council from the Retailing Department.

In answer to inquiries, it was announced that, at present, there is \$2,448.23 in the residual fund, which is to be reserved for unanticipated expenditures.

Ben Marcus announced that a total of 154 pints of blood had been donated during the Red Cross Blood Drive, and expressed thanks to everyone who helped make the drive a success.

Dave Levering spoke to Council concerning the World University Service of the World Students Service Fund, giving a resume of what had been accomplished during the past year, and asked that R.I.T. participate actively in the plan of mutual assistance among students throughout the world.

It was announced that the banking hours had been changed, and that beginning November 12, students may have their checks cashed or countersigned from 10:30 to 12:30 P.M. daily.

President Stumpf informed Council that it had been suggested that pledges of the various fraternities be enlisted to paint the main lounge in Clark Union. Brushes and paint would be supplied by the Student Association. Discussion followed. Action will be taken after details and costs have been announced.

Mr. Killup, of Bastian Bros., will be in the Student Council office on Monday, Nov. 12, at 4:00 and 7:00 P.M. to conduct the sale of class rings. Students of any class may order rings now.
