Student Council Minutes  
January 14, 1952

Pres. Jack Stumpf called the meeting to order at 5:05 P.M. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Phyllis Sprague reported that the redecoration program for Clark Union is still being organized. The Alumni Association will obtain a discount on the material needed to redecorate Clark Union. The following people are on the Lounge Committee:

Don Rickert recommended the Young Republican Club constitution for Council's approval. The constitution was read and Dave Schuckman moved that the Young Republican Club be accepted as a club at R.I.T. The motion was seconded and carried.

The Retailing and Electrical people are to elect senators after the meeting to complete the list of senators.

Jim Nolan has been appointed Chairman of Spring Weekend.

Jack Stumpf reported that Mrs. Townsend has asked to hold a card party Jan. 22 in the front room of Clark Union. Discussion followed and Don Hosley moved that Mrs. Townsend be permitted to hold a card party in room 100 at Clark Union. The motion was seconded and carried.

Len Ogden requested Council to remove the \$5 charge for using Clark Union for the Spring St. Dorm Council's Open House to be held Jan. 20, because the affair is open to all students and faculty and there will be no admission charge. Grenville Bentley moved that the Spring St. Dorm Council should have use of Clark Union Jan. 20 without the \$5 fee, but they pay the one dollar fee for the use of the kitchen. The motion was seconded and carried.

There will be another blood drive in the spring. Ben Marcus, Civic Activities Chairman, will name a chairman and a date for the next drive in the near future.

All social chairmen will meet in room 100 at Clark Union, Jan. 22 at 12:30 to plan the social calendar for the second semester.

Joe McKenna moved that the meeting be adjourned. The motion was seconded and carried. The meeting was adjourned at 5:55 P.M.
