## Student Council Minutes February 4, 1952

The meeting was called to order by President Jack Stumpf at 5:05 P.M. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. Roll call was taken.

Bill Reyman addressed Council regarding plans for the Spring Weekend, in which he amounced that funds allocated by the 1951-52 Budget would be insufficient to provide the usual entertainment facilities, and asked that the Spring Weekend Committee be allowed to raise the price of dance tickets. Discussion followed. John Higgins moved that the Committee be allowed to raise the price of tickets, at their disgression, to a maximum of \$5.00. Seconded and carried.

President Stumpf presented an attendance check, in which the percentage of meetings, for which the representative was eligible, was listed for each Council member. and he reviewed the article in the Student Association Constitution stating that any member, who, without an acceptable excuse, is not present for at least 65% of the meetings, will be asked to resign.

It was brought to Council's attention that some students are being careless in observing the rules regarding the use of Clark Union, and, if such conduct continues, that steps will have to be taken to insure enforcement.

It was announced that it is hoped that the painting of Clark Union Lounge will begin Saturday, February 9, pending clearence of the Lounge for the weekend.

Council was informed that various school organizations have shown an apparent lack of interest by not cooperating with Mr. Foster's Photo-Journalism class in publicising organizational activities.

It was announced that Mr. Davis, of Public Relations, has suggested that people applying for student enrollment for the following year be sent copies of the school publication to acquaint them with campus activities. Granville Bentley moved that the Student Council advise that copies of THE REPORTER be sent to prospective students, along with a letter of welcome. Seconded and carried.

An Inter-Organizational meeting will be held Tuesday, February 5, at 12:30 P.M., in Room 100 of Clark Union.

Mr. Killip, of Bastian Brothers, will be in hie Student Council Office, Wednesday, February 6, at 4 and 7 P.M.

Standing Committee reports are due next week, February 11.

Joe McKenna moved that the meeting be adjourned. Seconded and carried. Meeting adjourned at 5:55 P.M.
