## Student Council Minutes February 25, 1952

The meeting was called to order by President Jack Stumpf at 5:05 P.M. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. Roll call was taken.

The painting of Clark Union is near completion, but the Lounge will remain closed until the new floor is laid. It was announced that the Alumni Executive Council has voted to contribute \$150 toward the expense of the new floor which will total \$200. Discussion followed. Dave Schukman moved that \$50 be taken from the reserve fund to complete payment for the asphalt tile floor in Clakk Union. Seconded and carried.

It was announced that a quota of 600 pints of blood has been established for the approaching blood drive. To assist in meeting this quota, Council members were divided into two teems with the understanding that this contest would not supersede departmental or organizational drives. All blanks must be turned in at the Student Council office, on to hiss Behr, by Thursday, February 28. The losing team, Red Bloods or Blue Bloods, will treat the winners to an informal party to be held soon.

A letter from Meroury Publications, requesting a directory of students and faculty, was read. Discussion followed. It was decided that a letter similar to the one sent to TIME, Inc., be forwarded, explaining Council's stand as established at a previous meeting.

A letter was read from Dave Ramsey, Art Department, suggesting that an investigation be made of the absence of the American flag in all of the Institute buildings. It was decided that this matter be taken to the Administration for immediate consideration.

It was announced that Al Booth is requesting approval of Council to solicit money at R.I.T. for the Red Cross drive. Priscilla Holt moved that Council give approval to the drive. Seconded and carried.

The suggestion was made that the Easter vacation be lengthened. It was decided to bring the matter up before the Administration.

No information is available as yet as to the distribution date for the Student Directory.

Rings will be available in the Student Council office on Monday, March 10, at 4 and 7 P.M.

Don Rickert moved that the meeting be adjourned. Seconded an carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:05 P.M.
