TECHMILA

The following proposal was presented by Dick Nally.

"That each organization on Campus, having a Council approved Constitution and officers, as of September 10, 1956 be permitted to have one free page in the 1957 Techmila" (This proposal to include the Edgerton Park Council.) Organizations, which by tradition have had two pages-Reporter, Council, Fraternities and Sororities- shall be allowed to purchase one additional page at the cost of \$50.00.

The motion was made that the proposal be accepted and discussion followed as to whether the proposal was too general.

A motion to amend the main motion was made and carried stating that each organization on Campus be allowed one free page in the 1957 Techmila subject to the approval of the Publications Committee.

TECHMILA

A motion to amend the main motion reading not to allow free pages to Sororities and Fraternities was made and defeated. The amended main motion was passed and reads: " That each organization on Campus be given one free page in the 1957 Techmila, subject to the approval of the Publications Committee. (This proposal to include the Edgerton Park Council).

Organizations ,which by tradition, have had two pages-Reporter Council, Fraternities and Sororities- shall be allowed to purchase one additional page at the cost of \$50.00

The motion for adjournment was made and the meeting was adjourned at 6:15 p.m.
