

STUDENT COUNCIL MINUTES
May 5, 1952

The meeting was called to order by President Jack Stumpf at 5:05 P. M.

A letter of resignation from Bill Swart was received. In his place as freshman Mechanical representative Council welcomed Ralph Rosati.

The matter of elections was discussed.

Granville Bentley gave a report on the Awards Assembly to be held May 14, 1952 at 9:00 P. M. A discussion was held concerning the type of key to be given at the Assembly. Bill Tarow made a motion that we adopt the scalloped key as the standard form, to be used for the first time at this year's awards assembly. Motion seconded and carried. Dave Schuckman, Jack Sulinski, Jim McCue and Irma Wunsch volunteered to be ushers at the Awards Assembly.

Due to difficulty in collecting all unsold tickets, Jim Nolan was unable to give a complete report on Spring Weekend ticket sales at this meeting.

Two amendments to the Constitution were presented by Don Richert Chairman of Constitution Committee, concerning residual funds and committee chairmen. Discussion followed and the matter was tabled until next week.

Copies of the specifications for the Rudner Award were distributed to Council members and approved by the Council.

Jack Sulinski gave a report on Open House. Student Association display is to be placed in Assembly Hall.

Jim McCue reported on the Student Council informal meeting to be held Sunday, May 18 at Mrs. Robson's home in Scottsville.

Granville Bentley make a motion that election procedure be changed so that the time element of one week preceding nominations and elections be changed to not less than two days between each. This motion was made and carried.

Rings are to be sold March 19 at 4:00 and 7:00 P. M., Student Council office. Rings can be picked up at Bastians, 1600 No. Clinton Ave.

Lois Zierk reported that the Convocation invitations were sent special delivery from Massachusetts on Monday. Student Directorys were passed out for distribution among departments.
