The minutes of the previous meeting were read,
corrected and approved. The correction was that
the Lounge Committee reported that there might be

COMMITTEES

The Constitution Committee made a motion, which
was carried, that Council accept the Modern Jazz
Society and the American Chemical Society.

PUBLICATION

It was announced that the school directory would
be ready for publication at the beginning of the
second quarter.

LOUNGE

The Lounge Committee recommended that students
cooperate in the use of the Clark Lounge for
playing cards for it was doubtful that classrooms
would be available in the Clark Building.

BUDGET

A motion was made and carried that Council accept
the recommendations of the Budget Committee on the
budgets of both the Wrestling and Assembly Committees
which was to the effect that either group would be
allocated additional funds.

NEW BUSINESS

It was suggested to Council that a co-chairman be appointed to represent N.S.A. when the regular chairman is on block or cannot attend meetings. The matter was to be further investigated.

It was also brought to the Council's attention that the polio shots would conflict with the Blood Drive. Council was informed, however, that the date could not be changed because the Administration could not schedule the polio shots and since there has to be a six month period between blood donations this date could not be changed either; therefore the date remains as originally set.

A motion was made and carried that a representative of Council approach the Administration on the matter of keeping the Institute library opened on Saturday.

A motion was also made and carried that the Administration be asked to keep the facilities of the Institute open during assemblies.

SCHOOL WIDE ELECTIONS

A motion was made that Student Council direct the Constitution Committee to investigate the possibility of school-wide elections for Student Council officer formulate plans concerning such a program, and present the results of investigation and these plans to the Council for their consideration.

An amendment to this motion was made and carried to delete the words concerning the formulation of plans and presenting of these plans.

The previous motion was then moved and carried.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

A reminder was given of the assembly to be held Tuesday, November 5, 1956 at 11 o'clock in the RIT Chapel.

It was also announced that the Election Poll Party to be held Tuesday November 6, 1956, between 8:30 P.M. to 12:30 A.M. in the Snack Bar, would go on as scheduled.

The motion for adjournment was made and the meeting was adjourned at 5:40 P.M.
