The minutes of the previous meeting were read
and approved.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

The dates for Spring Weekend were announced
as May 3, 4 and 5. A recommendation of having
a jazz concert on the Sunday of Spring Weekend
was made to the Spring Weekend committee.

OLD BUSINESS

The Chairman of the Bulletin Board Committee
announced that the posters for Student Council
minutes were underway. A letter from Miss
Gutfrucht, of the Department of Art and Design,
concerning a special committee and advertising
for the bulletin boards was received by Student
Council and a motion was made and carried to
refer it to the Publications Committee.

A motion was made that Student Council sponsor
dances in the Gym following each of three re-
maining basketball games, with a band and a
small admission charge.

(Continued)

An amendment to this motion was made and defeated that the dances be presented by the fraternities and underwritten by Student Council.

A motion was then made and carried to withdraw the main motion; and another motion was made and carried to have Student Council finance a dance, with current operating funds, to follow the January 25th game. The dance will be planned by the Social Committee.

Recommendations such as a \$5.00 fine to owners of illegally parked cars, a reminder of the school principle of car registration, and a suggestion to have the school plows clear the parking lot, were made to help alleviate some of the problems concerning the student parking lot. President Ball suggested that the matter of the \$5.00 fine be tabled until next week so as to enable further discussion and investigation. A motion was then made and carried to accept the rest of the recommendations made by the Parking Lot committee.

NEW BUSINESS

A problem of non-scheduled meetings conflicting with organizational events was brought before Council. President Ball said he would look into this matter and report to Council.
