Minutes of the previous meeting were read,  
corrected and approved.

CONSTITUTION

A list of proposed amendments to the Student  
Association Constitution were distributed to  
the Council members. These amendments will be  
voted on next week. With the exception of  
Article XIII, Section 6, the amendments have  
changed only the wording of certain sections  
in most cases. Section 6 under Article XIII  
reads:

All funds received by organizations  
which are granted allotments by Student  
Council shall be deposited with the In-  
stitute Cashier, for credit to the account  
of the organization. No separate bank  
accounts or other funds may be maintained  
by such organizations.

PARKING LOT

Lists of recommendations for the R.I.T. Student  
Parking Lot were handed out for the Council  
members to read and consider. Al Rossetto,  
chairman of the Parking Lot Committee, ex-  
plained several of the recommendations which  
will all be discussed at the next meeting of  
Council.

The Chair asked the Council to be considering  
means by which student parking lot stickers  
could be sold next year.

**SOCIAL COMMITTEE**

Don Lenhard reported that the Social Committee is planning the distribution of a questionnaire in an attempt to discover what the student body is interested in.

**STUDENT DIRECTORY**

The Chair reported that a meeting had been held concerning the publication of the student directory. Since the estimated cost of printing is \$1200 and Council has appropriated \$975 for the cost of printing, the Chair asked that Council appropriate \$225 to cover the additional expense. Robert Kohler made the motion and Robert Wahl seconded it that Council appropriate the additional \$225. The motion was carried. The student directory will be ready for distribution on February 20th.
