The minutes of the previous meeting, of February 10, were approved as read.

Mr. Robert Belknap took the floor and announced that there will be a change of advisor to Student Council effective September 1958. Mr. Eugene Fram, of the Retailing Department, will be the new advisor and will work in close cooperation with Mr. Belknap for the remainder of this year. Mr. Belknap stressed the importance of cooperation between the students and their advisor. It must be kept in mind that we Council members are under constant pressure from our constituents, but also the advisor is responsible to the Administration.

Legislative and Financial

Bob Kohler read a letter from Dr. Ellingson who proposed that school-wide elections be held this year on a trial basis and then be reviewed again by next year's Council and the Administration.

Since Dr. Bruce Partridge has left the Institute and Mr. Frank Benz has replaced him, the Student Association will have a new treasurer. It was moved by Bob Kohler that we authorize Mr. Benz to sign checks for the Student Association. The motion was seconded and passed.

NEW BUSINESS

John Markowski suggested that a public telephone be installed at the Student Union. He was appointed to investigate these possibilities.

It was moved that the President write a letter to the Administration to eliminate the Genesee Valley Figure Skating Club from skating on the rink during R.I.T. time since R.I.T. is not allowed on the rink during the exclusive Club time. However, this motion was unnecessary when Mr. Belknap volunteered to take care of this matter.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:55 p.m.
