

ROCHESTER INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY
Student Council Minutes
November 17, 1952

The meeting was called to order at 5:05 p.m. by President David Schuckman. Roll call was taken. The minutes were read and approved.

In reply to the letter sent to Dr. Ellingson concerning the extension of the five-minute break between classes to ten minutes, it was stated by Dr. Ellingson that such a change would not be advisable at this time. However, Dr. Ellinson also stated that a number of changes in schedules were being considered and that the matter of the extension would be brought before the Policy Committee at the appropriate time.

Mr. Rider feels it is not necessary that the Clark Bldg. clock be moved into the lounge. Council decided to press the matter further.

A letter from Miss Symonds was received stating that it is not possible to have the door between the cafeteria and the Eastman Lounge open to the students. Council then suggested that a milk machine be placed in the lounge. However, the opinion was that before any action is possible it will be necessary to have a clean-up campaign in the lounge.
