

ROCHESTER INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY
Student Council Minutes
December 8, 1952

The meeting was called to order by President David Schuckman at 5:05 p.m. Roll call was taken. The minutes were read and approved.

President Schuckman reported on subjects of interest to students that came up during his meeting with Dr. Ellingson.

1. Basketball playing in the Eastman Annex courts has been approved and will be managed by Harris Rusitsky.
2. Dr. Ellingson suggested that a comparative study of prices will be necessary to determine the cost of articles in the book store in relation to those which can be bought elsewhere.
3. Caps and gowns will not be used in the Institute this year for convocation; however, Dr. Ellingson said that he has given permission for each department to hold its own graduation.
4. There is no set Institute rule on the matter of how long to wait for an instructor after the bell rings. This matter however may have a standard rule in each department.

Roger Moore moved that a survey be taken to determine how many students are interested in playing intramural basketball; the motion was seconded and carried. The survey forms will be placed on each department bulletin board.

Mrs. Miller gave a very interesting talk on her trip to Colgate University to the recent conference of the Association of College Unions. She stressed the importance of increasing student participation in activities and along with this the need to increase school spirit.

There will be a Christmas party in the Clark Union Lounge, Tuesday, December 9, at 7:30 p.m.

Mr. Belknap suggested that complaints brought up by students should be carefully analyzed and only those of greatest importance be brought before Council.

The suggestion made by the Dorm Council for placing a new television set in the Clark Union Lounge or at least repairing the present set was referred to the Lounge Committee.

At 5:50 p.m. Bill Clarke moved that the meeting be adjourned.
