

ROCHESTER INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY
Student Council Minutes
February 2, 1953

The meeting was called to order at 5:05 p.m. by President Schuckman. Roll call was taken. The minutes were read and approved.

All committee chairmen gave brief reports on the January activities of their respective committees.

For the rest of the school year, parking lot tickets will be sold for two dollars. Tickets may be purchased in the Student Council office from 12:30 to 1:00 p.m. each Monday.

Mr. Belknap informed Council that a clock costing \$7.46 has been ordered for the Clark Building Lounge.

President Schuckman reported that the bulletin board for Inter-Organization Council would cost about \$30.00. It was decided not to erect the board.

The question of a further appropriation for the RIT Choraliers was again brought up and discussed. For the group to continue as they have been, two nights a week, they would need an additional \$500. A motion that Council give the maximum sum of \$250 to the Choraliers, to best use at their discretion, was introduced, seconded, and carried.

There will be an Inter-Organization meeting Tuesday, February 2, at 7:00 p.m.

Mr. Kilip, ring salesman, will be in the Student Council Office Thursday, February 5, at 4:00 and at 7:00 p.m. Students who purchased their rings last fall may pick them up Thursday. New orders may be placed also.

There was further discussion on the abuse of the smoking lounges by RIT students. Council agreed that sufficient warnings have been given to the students and that it was time to take action. A motion that the Eastman Lounge be closed Wednesday, February 4, at 4:00 p.m. and not reopened for a week was seconded and carried.

After one week the lounge will be reopened for a trial period of indefinite length. During the trial period the students will have to prove that they will not further use their lounge privileges. If they do, the lounge will remain open; if not, it will be closed permanently.

Bill Clark moved that the meeting be adjourned at 6:05 p.m. The motion was seconded and carried.
