Student Council Minutes
February 9, 1953

The meeting was called to order at 5:05 p.m.. Roll call was taken. The minutes were read and approved.

On Thursday, February 12, the Eastman Lounge will be re-opened. A question was raised as to whether or not students should be permitted to continue eating their lunches in the lounge. After much discussion a motion that students be prohibited from eating their noontime lunches in the Eastman Lounge was seconded and carried. One of the Cafeteria dining rooms will be made available to the students as a place where lunches may be eaten.

Council discussed the present arrangement of allotting the bulk of the Student Association budget to a few major activities, with the result that little is left to appropriate to the many minor activities.

President Schuckman asked for suggestions or changes Council might think advisable pertaining to some new plan whereby the budget could be more evenly distributed. Discussion followed with several suggestions made. No decisions were reached.
