The meeting was called to order at 5:05 p.m. by President Schuckman. Roll call was taken. The minutes were read and approved.

Discussion followed. It was decided to consult faculty members from each department to see if they would be willing to devote a short period of class time each week for this purpose.

Bill Clarke suggested that the juke box in the Eastman lounge be regulated so that three records could be played for a dime. This plan will be suggested to the Lounge Committee.

A juke box for the Clark Lounge was requested. The request will be handled through the Lounge Committee.

Bernie Boston has been appointed chairman of the Awards Committee. Granville Bentley will assist Bernie for the duration of his school block.

Granville Bentley asked why the Commerce Department lockers could not be moved. Discussion followed. Mr. Rider will be sonsulted on the matter.

Mary Kramer asked why students are permitted to smoke in evening school classes. President Schuckman stated that Student Council has no jurisdiction over the matter as it is an Evening School policy.
