

ROCHESTER INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY
Student Council Minutes
March 2, 1953

The meeting was called to order at 5:10 p.m. by President Schuckman. Roll call was taken. The minutes were read and approved.

Barbara Bartenstein gave a brief report on the success of the Blood Drive held February 25. Barbara reported that a total of 173 pints of blood were donated.

President Schuckman asked for volunteers to help collect and alphabetize student names for the Student Directory soon to be printed. Granville Bentley and Jerry Calderon volunteered their assistance.

There will be an Inter-Organization meeting Tuesday, March 3, at 7:00 p.m.

A question was raised as to whether or not Council should permit commercial advertisements to be posted in the school lounges. Discussion followed. Granville Bentley moved that commercial advertising be prohibited in the school lounges, with the exception of signs painted on the vending machines. The motion was seconded and carried.

Mr. Davis and Don Bouton spoke to Council on Techmila's allotment from the budget. There was considerable discussion. The major questions are "Is Techmila receiving too great a share of the student budget?", and if so, "How can its expenses be cut without too seriously impairing the quality of the yearbook?" No decisions were reached.

Bill Clarke moved the meeting be adjourned at 5:55 p.m. The motion was seconded and carried.
