Student Council Meeting Minutes
October 19, 1959

President Lloyd called the meeting to order at 5:10 p.m. Minutes were read and approved. Roll call was taken; the following were not present:

DIVISION REPORTS

Student Affairs: John Sturge announced that plans for the blood drive are underway. A meeting for all members was scheduled for Wed. in E 120.

Social: Fred Guevara announced that the Rochester Womens Club is interested in providing a room in the basement of the Presbyterian Church for student recreation. Members of the Women's Club would be hostesses at open houses each Friday and Saturday night.

Guevara then made the motion that a committee be formed take charge of such a recreation center, to be ready by Nov. 6.

The motion was seconded, voted upon and passed.

Publications and Publicity: Jim Brennan announced that student association cards were ready for representatives to distribute.

John Buesh asked for volunteers to assist in this years Leadership training conference.

President Lloyd announced the alumni banquet would be held November 14th at the Chamber of Commerce. Guest speaker will be Dr. Werner Von Braun. Ten student leaders from RIT will be sent to attend this program. Everyone is urged to attend; tickets may be purchased for 6.50.

OLD BUSINESS

Fred Guevara moved to suspend article 13 of the constitution so that the raise of the student association fee could be discussed. The motion was seconded, voted upon and carried.

Joe burroughs distributed mimeographed material explaining the primary objectives of the raise and again reviewed the proposal with council.

The floor was then opened to discussion. Mr. Fram stated disapproval of the raise on the basis that costs could be cut in many areas on the budget. Several students expressed the view that cutting would cost in prestige and actually save very little money. It was also pointed out that the greeks, rather than council, experience most of the losses on weekends.

Bob Moore moved the previous question. The motion was seconded and carried.

A roll call vote on the main motion was taken; the motion was passed by a 23-16 majority.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:30p.m..
