The minutes were read and the following corrections made:

- 2) In the motion made by Fred Guevara under Social change "three weeks" to read "two weeks."
- 3) Under Publicity and Publications concerning wives' Student Association cards change "main office" to "Student Activities Office."

#### DIVISION REPORTS

Social Division - Fred Guevara asked that the president direct elimination of Section 7c and revision of Section 6 of the Book of Statutes/ under Social Scheduling to read: "closed functions may be scheduled at the same time as a home athletic event. No open functions may be scheduled at the same time as a home athletic event."

Student Affairs- After explanation of student complaints by John Sturge John Beusch moved that Council recommend to the administration that the T shaped lot behind the gym be set aside for day student use during the evening. Discussion followed and the previous question was moved, voted upon and passed. The main motion was voted upon and passed.

John Beusch moved that Council recommend to the administration that the majority of limited parking areas on Washington, Troup and Spring Streets be changed to all day parking. The previous question was moved, voted upon, and passed. The main motion was voted upon and passed.

After discussion Tom Franz moved that graduate students be charged \$10.00 for parking lot stickers. It was discussed and moved to postpone action on this. This was voted upon and passed.

Mr Sturge also announced that the Blood Drive will be postponed until February due to the fact that RIT students showed little interest at this time in donating blood.

Legislative and Financial - Joe Burroughs announced that

freshman members will be present at the meeting next week.

#### COMMITTEE REPORTS

Judicial Committee - Bob Soloman reported that the plans of the committee are currently being considered by the administration.

Constitution Committee - Bob Moore announced a meeting at 7:30 Thursday at the Student Union.

#### NEW BUSINESS

Joe Burroughs introduced the budget submitted for approval by the Budget Committee. Mr Burroughs then moved that the Student Association Budget Appropriation recommended by the Budget Committee be approved by Council. Upon request John Lattimore discussed Techmila and amended the motion to raise the Techmila budget to \$25,000. After discussion Don Quant moved to table the motion until the following week. This was voted upon and passed. The meeting was adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
