The minutes were read and approved.

Except for important matters the normal order of business was suspended in order that Council could consider the budget.

John Beusch announced a meeting of the Leadership Training Committee on Thursday at 12:30.

The motion concerning the Student Council budget was removed from the floor. Discussion followed and the previous question was moved, voted upon and passed. The amendment was voted upon and passed.

Discussion began on organizational budgets:

Archery Club- Henry Segal moved that the amendment be amended to allocate \$120.00 to the Archery Club. Discussion followed and the previous question was moved, voted upon and passed.

Chess Club - Tom Prantz moved that the amendment be amended to raise the Chess Club allocation to \$350.00. Bob Garrison objected to consideration of the motion. The objection was passed.

Forensic- It was moved that the revised Forensic budget allocation be accepted by Council. Discussion followed and the motion was voted upon and passed.

Hockey Club- Joe Burroughs read a letter from Mr. Belknap indicating that the Student Activities Office felt that this was a burden that should not assumed by Council. Discussion followed and John O'Conner moved that the amendment be amended to allocate \$1557.39 to the Hockey Club. The previous question was moved, voted upon and passed. The amendment was defeated in a roll call vote of 18-17.

After questions and an appeal to the chair the chair ruled that the vice-president may vote on any question on the floor. Jim Anderson appealed the ruling of the chair. Discussion followed and Mr Anderson withdrew his appeal.

The main motion was voted upon and passed.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:30 P.M.
