President Lloyd conducted a "straw poll" on the results brought in by members concerning the feasibility of sending Reporters to block students. The results were then passed on to the Reporter staff.

NEW BUSINESS

Tom Frantz moved that the By-laws, Article 1, sections 1 and 2, be replaced by the following: (to become section 10)

"Division heads shall be elected by the Council members for the following divisions: Legislative and Financial, Publicity and Publications, Leadership, Student Affairs, and Social. Such elections would be held at the annual meeting following the message of the president. At this time the incoming president shall present a slate of five candidates (one per office) and nominations shall be opened from the floor."

Discussion followed and the previous question was moved, voted upon and passed. The main motion was voted upon and passed.

Bob Solomon presented his report on the Judiciary Court. Joe Burroughs moved that this be tabled until next week. This was voted upon and passed.

Mort Polsky suggested that Council send a division head to the next IFC meeting to protect the interest of the general student body in a case the IFC is trying. President Lloyd appointed Jim Brennan to do this.

The motion was made to set up a committee to check the possibilities of having a Student Council summer committee. The motion was voted upon and passed. Members of the committee are:
