Advertising:

On Monday, March 28, letters will be sent to block students. Campaign material which candidates wish to include, must be in room A212, at noon on Monday to be included.

Henry Segall and Joe Farage are in charge of candidates advertising and publicity. It is their prerogative to judge all material for content and possible slander. Any candidate who feels he is being unjustly attacked by his fellow opponents, must register such a complaint with election chairman Jim Anderson immediately.

The April 8 issue of the Reporter will carry full coverage on the campaign. All candidates must submit the necessary written material to Bob Garrison by March 31.

The campaign will start on Monday April 4. A coffee hour will be held that noon for the entire student body: candidates will hold informal discussions at this time.

Committee Recommendations:

An allotment of \$25. to vice pres. as well as president to finance their campaigns.

As of March 24, additional candidates must submit a petition of 100 names, to the election board to be eligible as nominees.

When there are three or more candidates running for the same office, the plurality of votes will win.
