The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Budget Committee made the following comments for Council's consideration in regard to Techmila.

- (1) More ads should be included.
- (2) One of every three dollars of the budget goes for Techmila.
- (3) \$250-\$300 was lost by mistakes last year.
- (4) Production was not well handled.
- (5) Each organization should be represented in the book and pay for their space.

It was brought up that some students feel that out of the Student Association dues that they pay, the only thing that they can actually see and take with them from R.I.T. is the Techmila.

Earl Wolf, assisted by Kent Hill, presented the staff's views with regard to Techmila.

It was also questioned if the quality of the paper used in the Techmila could be cut, also if bids were taken for parts of the book.

John Pownall made the motion to give Techmila \$8500 plus whatever they collect of last year's unpaid bills. Ed Watson seconded this motion, and the motion was passed.

In the report on the Cashier's office it was stated that checks are cashed from money taken in during the day's normal activity. No special fund is set up for cashing checks as this would mean several thousand extra dollars would have to be kept on hand to meet the demand on certain days.

At 6:00 p.m. the motion for adjournment was made and seconded.
