

REPORT OF SOCIAL COMMITTEE MEETING
December 10, 1956

The committee recommends that:

The Student Council supports the presentation of the Masquers Guild Costume Ball on February 9, 1957 in the R. I. T. Gym.

Purpose of Such Action:

- 1) To supplement the lagging Social Program
- 2) To raise the caliber of the social activities with a big name band.
- 3) To give a trial run to the large scale social policies planned by the committee.
- 4) To aid initiation of scholarship fund.

Details of recommendation:

- 1) Student Council assume all financial responsibilities of this dance (approx. \$1200- 1400).
- 2) From the gross receipts of the dance, Student Council will subtract \$500. Any gross receipts in excess of \$500 will be split 25% - 75% Student Council and Masquers Guild. Masquers Guild portion will be donated to the R.I.T. Scholarship Fund.
- 3) The dance is to be advertised as:
"Presented by Masquers Guild"
"Supported by Students Council"
- 4) The Masquers Guild will assume all detail and related work involved in holding the affair.
- 5) The committee recommends that the money to support this affair be drawn from the surplus fund of Student Council.

Controls by Student Council

- 1) Final approval of the band with the above committee in conjunction with the President and Faculty Advisor of Student Council.
