The minutes of the previous meeting were read and corrected.

President Boston called upon Robert Schneider as spokesman for the Constitution Committee. He read the revisions of the two sections in question:

Article IV, Section 8: Instead of speaking privileges for an outsider to be obtained 2 weeks in advance, it would be necessary to obtain permission 10 days in advance. If there is a matter needing urgent attention, the request may be read at the next meeting at the discretion of the President. It must be submitted the Friday before, however.

Article VI, Section 4: Instead of the Nominating Committee being comprised of 3 freshmen and 2 upperclassmen, it will consist of 2 freshmen and 3 upperclassmen.

Ed Watson made the motion that Council approve these two changes and that the President Pro Tem automatically be a member of the next year's Council. John Bailey seconded the motion, and it was passed by Council.

Other measures were also inaugurated: That the Spring Weekend Committee be a standing committee and that records be kept of all elections, so that, if a member must resign, the second highest nominee will fill the vacancy. Ed Watson made the motion that these measures be adopted. Todd Ruede seconded the motion, and it was passed by Council.

Ed Watson then made the motion that the entire Constitution, with revisions, be accepted by Council. (Harris Rusitzky) Todd Ruede seconded the motion, and it was unanimously passed by Council.
