Drafts of the Student Association Constitution were distributed.

DIVISION REPORTS

ORGANIZATION AFFAIRS

Larry Albertson presented the Constitution of the R.I.T. Young Republicans Club and indicated that it had been approved by his committee and the administration. Al Vezza moved that Council accept the constitution of the R.I.T. Young Republicans Club. He amended his motion to accept the Young Republicans' Constitution providing that it be revised to include the stipulation that the group will receive no monies from the Student Association. OLD BUSINESS

President Beusch announced an executive committee meeting to be held Tuesday noon in E243. He also pointed out that Council members are required to attend 75% of the Council Meetings. He indicated that only 3 meetings can be missed this quarter by any member.

NEW BUSINESS

President Beusch asked for volunteers to arrange for the selection of candidates in the spring for Who's Who in American Colleges and Universities. There were no volunteers.

Jim Anderson suggested that Student Council express the thanks of the students for the new system of attendance. He also suggested that the Election Board of Control be set up during this quarter in order to facilitate more efficient procedures in the spring.

In response to questions President Beusch announced that the salesman from Joslyns will be at R.I.T. during December and that students who order rings at that time will have them by graduation.

Mr. Milour suggested that those organizations with requisitions to have approved plan ahead due to the fact that they will only be approved once a week.
