DIVISION REPORTS

INTERNAL AFFAIRS

Mail folders are now available in the Foods Department.

Motion was made to have Student Council increase the salary of the Student Union student proctor to \$1.25 per hour. The motion was passed.

CAMPUS ACTIVITIES

Fred Babcock has been selected as chairman for the blood drive.

Those students who have not made arrangements for the payment of their parking fines will receive class suspensions on Monday.

The Alumni Banquet has been cancelled. The alumni will participate in some of our scheduled Parent's Weekend events.

ORGANIZATIONAL AFFAIRS

Bruce Fredericks gave notice that anyone removing or destroying expensive posters on bulletin boards will have action taken against them.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

HOCKEY COMMITTEE

Results of the poll will be in the next REPORTER. According to unofficial Athletic Committee estimates, the expense of an intercollegiate hockey team will be about \$5,000 to \$7,000 per year in addition to initial changes for the ice rink.

STUDENT UNION COMMITTEE

The NSID met and has decided on a color scheme for the Student Union.

IDENTIFICATION CARD COMMITTEE

Sample ID cards will soon be available for inspection. As soon as they are ready, they will be sent out for estimates on the photography and laminating work to be done.

NEW BUSINESS

Figures from our latest financial report were presented to show representatives the surplus existing in our funds, some of which is the result of income from various operations. Representatives were asked to be thinking of means by which to better use these funds.
