STUDENT COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
November 1, 1961

The meeting was called to order by the president. Roll call was taken and the minutes of the previous meeting were read as corrected.

DIVISION REPORTS

INTERNAL AFFAIRS

Printed committee report forms are available for chairmen to submit weekly.

Council passed a motion by Don Lehmbeck that Student Council allocate \$334 to send six students to the collegiate council for the United Nations conference in New York City on November 10 and 11. The subject of the conference is to be "1961 UN Year of Crisis." Three representatives are chosen by the administration from those students maintaining a high average and showing an interest in international affairs. The remaining three are to be chosen by the Executive Committee of Student Council.

CAMPUS AFFAIRS

Parents Weekend was termed a success with a luncheon attendance of approximately 610 people.

ORGANIZATIONAL AFFAIRS

Each representative was asked to become familiar with Student Council Constitutions and By-Laws, copies of which are in each folder.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

HOCKEY COMMITTEE

In a recent discussion, Dr. Ellingson voiced the following objections which might be made in connection with the proposed introduction of intercollegiate hockey:

1. Expense of equipping and operating a team
2. Cost of renovating the ice rink
3. Interference with public skating time
4. Difficulty of competing against other teams without offering scholarships

Approval might be possible, however, if the Athletic Committee comes through with a strong proposal for its adoption and a source of funds is available. Russ Trimble suggested that we consider transferring a portion of the present Student Association fee to the Athletic fee for use in establishing a team and renovating the rink.

There will be a hockey game with the U of R Saturday, November 11, from 5 to 6 p.m. at the War Memorial. A pep rally will precede the game at 4:30 in the quad. All are encouraged to attend.
