SPECIAL STUDENT COUNCIL MEETING  
November 20, 1961

A motion was made to the effect that Council go on record as being in favor of RIT relocating at the Henrietta site. In any case, we respect the Board's dedicated judgment; and we will support any decision they make. The motion was carried.

A motion was made that Student Council allocate \$10,000 from the surplus fund towards furnishing and providing facilities in the new RIT Student Union. After a motion for the previous question following a discussion and the defeat of a motion to lay the main motion on the table until such time as representatives may consult their constituents, the main motion was carried.

Following the passage of these motions, everyone present was given speaking privileges for the planning of a rally November 21 at 3:55 a.m.
