SOCIAL DIVISION

BUSINESS

A motion was made that the office of radio station WITR be removed from that organization's use and reverted to use as a regular Student Union meeting room, open to any organization on campus. The motion was tabled until next week when WITR could be contacted.

As the result of an Executive Committee meeting, those organizations on campus receiving Student Association funds are being requested to come to Council meetings and report on their activities and use of funds as well as being prepared to answer questions.

There will be a work party for Student Council members this Saturday and Sunday from 1 to 5 p.m. All members should plan to work one of the two days.

The section of the Constitution dealing with grade point requirements for members was read to answer the questions of several representatives.
