DIVISION REPORTS

ORGANIZATIONAL AFFAIRS

Council passed motions to accept the constitutions of the RIT Choraliers and the Art School Art Society.

INTERNAL AFFAIRS

A report was made that the International Students Club is no longer functioning as an organization. The Alma Mater Committee has been working and is also considering the possibility of a fight song. - -

A survey is being conducted with 38 other campuses by the Budget Committee to gain figures of comparison. Organizations will no longer be able to travel without turning in receipts for reimbursement as of this weekend.

A motion was passed that Council accept the budget of \$275 of the RIT Choraliers. Budget request forms are now being sent to organizations receiving money from the Student Association.

CAMPUS AFFAIRS

A reminder was made that vehicles must be reregistered by February 12. A tentative date has been set for The Student Council banquet for Thursday, in the first week of May.

NEW BUSINESS

An Election Board of Control will be formed next week under the co-chairmanship of Terry Sholley and Pete Zando.

The motion concerning the revision of the constitution will be voted upon next week.
