

STUDENT COUNCIL MINUTES
MAY 31, 1949

The meeting was called to order at 5 P.M. by vice-pres. Bill Murphy. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

At this time Vice-president William Patrick Murphy turned the meeting over to the new president Joe Loughlin. Joe expressed his appreciation to Council for the position of such an office.

The motion was made that the meeting be adjourned. Seconded. The meeting was adjourned at 5:28 P.M.
