Student Council Minutes
October 24, 1949

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 P.M. by President Joe Loughlin. Roll was taken. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and accepted.

Laura Goldman read a letter from the Alumni Association stating that the Alumni Association will contribute \$100.00 to the Student Association for a student mixer. Posters advertising this mixer will show the fact that the Alumni Association is sponsoring this event. The Association has also granted \$50.00 for the purchase of magazines for Clark Union, Kate Gleason and the nurses office. Dora Schaefer made a motion that we accept this gift of \$100.00 and acknowledge it with a letter of thanks to the Alumni Association. The motion was seconded and carried.

President Loughlin again requested that Council members choose a member from within each department to serve on the Class Advisory Committee. It is imperative that these members be selected as soon as possible so that the committee might function immediately.

Ed Posner introduced Lowell Wentworth, a student representative, chosen by the Photo-Tech department students to represent them at department faculty meetings. Mr. Wentworth serves as Student Faculty liaison and has an equal vote in all matters. Mr. Wentworth suggested that other departments determine if this plan is feasible.

Steve Andras read a report submitted by Thomas Nantka, editor of Techmila, relative to his trip to Detroit for the Associate College Press Convention. It was pointed out by this report that the 1949 Techmila was rated first class by the editors. The Convention concerned itself with the problems of publishing and financing student year books.

Mrs. Robson informed Council that she has submitted the resolution concerning the Christmas recess to the Policy Committee. The Policy Committee accepted the resolution and although it is impossible to take any remedial action this year, the committee will consider this problem in the next calendar year and acknowledged the manner in which this problem was approached.

Nominations were held for the alternate vice-president. Claudia Symonds nominated Steve Andras. Al Cronig nominated Frank Rabiega. Clarence Mathews nominated John Wait. Each candidate introduced himself. Elections will be held next week, October 31, 1949.

Pat Minton made a motion that the meeting be adjourned. Seconded. Carried. The meeting was adjourned at 5:35 P.M.
